

About the Music:

- Instruments: String Quartet
- Introduction includes a descending passage from the first and second violin.
- The viola plays the tune while Dan sings the tune.
- The introduction is then repeated (an interlude) and Monica sings the tune.

Activities:

- 1. Listen to the introduction from the violins, imitate the rhythm pattern and clap it.
- 2. Raise hands when Dan sings.
- 3. Raise hands when introduction returns and clap the pattern of the introduction.
- 4. Raise hands when Monica sings.
- 5. Clap on rhyming words such as *doo* and *shoe*.
- 6. Skip to the beat while singing the song.
