
The Man in the Moon

About the Music:

- Instruments: Percussion Glockenspiel
- Dan recites the rhyme very slowly while the glockenspiel plays freely.
- Monica and Julie make 'ooh' sounds as Dan recites for the second time.

Activities:

- 1. Choose a glockenspiel and make free patterns while the rhyme is said.
- 2. Add a triangle to the glockenspiel and build layers of sound.
- 3. Add a bass drum and have the bass drum play slowly to match Dan's reading.
- 4. Make up some sounds of your own to go with Monica's and Julie's sounds.
- 5. Find out what *plum-porridge* is.
- 6. Move very freely to the rhyme but move as silently as you can.
