

An Apple for the King

About the Music:

- Instruments: String Quartet
- Four-bar introduction by the string quartet.
- Monica, Julia and Dan sing the song while the string quartet provides an 'oom-pah' style of accompaniment.
- The song is sung three times. The second and third times are in higher keys.

Activities:

1. Raise hands when they hear the voices enter.
2. Raise hands when they hear the music move to each new verse.
3. Sing song with Monica, Julie and Dan.
4. Clap on the words **apple**, **king**, **pear** and **queen**.
5. Walk, clap or stamp the beat while singing.
6. Trace the pattern of the pitch of the song with hands.
