
Cobbler, Cobbler

About the Music:

- Instruments: Percussion Temple Block
- Trio says rhyme three times, each time getting softer.
- Interlude between each recitation using opening rhythm.

Activities:

- 1. Learn the introductory rhythm by listening carefully to the temple blocks.
- 2. What do you notice about the temple blocks when the trio is reciting the first verse? Learn this pattern.
- 3. What do you notice about the temple blocks when the trio is reciting the second verse? Learn this pattern also.
- 4. What do you notice about the temple blocks when the trio is reciting the third verse? Learn this pattern also.
- 5. Find your own clapping patterns for each verse.
- 6. Transfer your clapping patterns to percussion instruments and play them for each other. Explain how your patterns work.
