### About the Music:

- Instruments: Percussion - Temple Block
- Trio says rhyme three times, each time getting softer.
- Interlude between each recitation using opening rhythm.

### Activities:

2. What do you notice about the temple blocks when the trio is reciting the first verse? Learn this pattern.
3. What do you notice about the temple blocks when the trio is reciting the second verse? Learn this pattern also.
4. What do you notice about the temple blocks when the trio is reciting the third verse? Learn this pattern also.
5. Find your own clapping patterns for each verse.
6. Transfer your clapping patterns to percussion instruments and play them for each other. Explain how your patterns work.
